## Colorado River agreements set

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Secretary of Interior Stewart L. Udall Tuesday announced agreements with private utilities for their participation in the backbone power transmission system of the Colorado River Storage Project.

The Bureau of Reclamation estimates the cost of the federal system at \$151,500,000.

Udall said the agreements will mean a reduction of \$27 million in the cost of the system as originally planned for all-federal construction in Colorado, Utah, Arizona, Wyoming, and New Mexico.

This \$27 million will be the cost of the line the government will not build. The private power utilities will set up their own transmission systems for wheeling and interconnections in certain areas to meet government requirements.

Udall in a news conference announcement said the plan achieves administration goals of:

—Maximum savings for the Upper Colorado Storage Basin fund, which will be made up of power funds to be used to pay off participating projects and to finance major dams and reclamation projects in the basin.

—Full protection of the service rights of preference customers at the lowest possible rates.

—Strengthening of the federal system through interconnections with facilities of private power companies.
