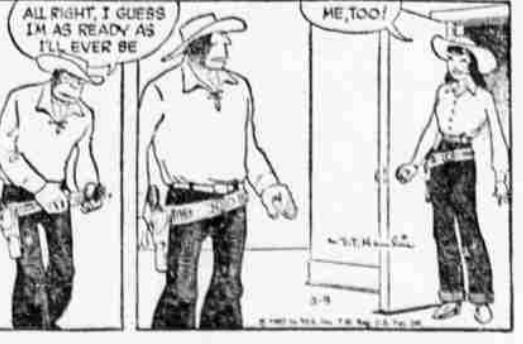

Accidents take lives of three

WASHINGTON (UPI) — President Kennedy has vetoed his first bill during this congressional session and it means a retired Army employe in Hawaii will have to do without an extra \$262.45.

The money would have gone to Charles J. Utterback of Aiea for being erroneously placed on leave without pay for 12 days during 1959. Kennedy said retirement credit given Utterback was adequate compensation for the government's error.

Tuthill, an engineering technician for Clackamas County, was struck and killed by a dump truck at a county road project at West Linn during the afternoon. The Roberts boy lost his life when struck by a Southern Pacific freight train at Toledo near his home. The accident occurred at night.

Vearrier was killed in a one-car early morning accident in Salem. His car struck a post on a bridge.
