



17-nation conference in recess

GENEVA (UPI) — The Western powers will refuse to join any controlled moratorium on nuclear testing no matter what Russia does during the Christmas recess of the disarmament conference, it was learned today.

The 17-nation conference went into recess Thursday night Jan. 15. Western delegates said the United States and Britain will make no effort to match the U. S. S. R. should the Russians declare unilaterally that they will cease testing after the first of the year.

The Russians have hinted they might make such a declaration. Thursday their spokesman here, Alexei Roschin, said that he did not "rule out the possibility" the West might go along.

Remember Russian Violation

But American Ambassador Arthur H. Dean has said over and over again that the West will never accept an unpoliced moratorium because of the way the Russians broke the last one.

Dean planned to fly home today to report on the failure of the latest round of Geneva talks to break either the deadlock on nuclear testing or on a general and complete disarmament treaty.

The talks have gone on for nine months, 95 plenary meetings and 50 sessions of the three nation subcommittee on a nuclear test ban. The subcommittee is made up of the United States, Britain and Russia.

Far From Agreement

The basic positions of the United States and Russia are as far apart as ever.

The West has said, however, that it hopes for a change of heart by the Russians in 1963. A sign of whether or not this is likely, according to Western observers, will be the name of the man who will head the Russian delegation when the conference resumes.

For the past month, veteran negotiator Semyon K. Tsarapkin has headed the Russian team here. Tsarapkin is considered a "hard man" to bargain with.

If some "moderate" takes his place, it may be an indication that the Russians at last are ready to do business.

KEATING NOT SATISFIED

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Sen. Kenneth B. Keating, R-N.Y., said Thursday night he was not satisfied that all Soviet offensive missiles had been removed from Cuba.

Keating said that he felt there was an "excessive amount" of Soviet arms and men in Cuba and "guns, tanks and MIG planes are still coming in — this past week."
