Pilot project targets county growth

A pilot project aimed at economic development at the county level may improve Wallowa County's ability to identify new economic growth areas and get projects underway.

The Association of Oregon Counties (AOC), which advocates for the interests of county governments, has announced the launch of the Oregon County Solutions Center (OCSC) to assist counties in developing new growth projects.

Greg Wolf, former administrator of the Regional Solutions Team under Gov. Kitzhaber, will administer the Solutions Center. Wolf started his new job in April and plans to meet with county commissioners throughout the state in the next few months.

The Solutions Center project is currently funded for five months at \$5,000 per month, but may become an ongoing program.

Wolf is interested in supporting counties because, "we've found that commissioners are uniquely qualified to convene people at the local level," he said. "I've had enough experience in this field to know how to do it (manage a project from idea to work-group).

"I know how to frame the project so everyone is comfortable working on it and I know how county commissioners can convene these projects.

'We know what this looks like and how to do it. The bigger question is how to get the (supporting) infrastructure in place.'

Wolf will be using his plaint in Enterprise. beginner budget to figure out now to get the resources required to support the work of county commissioners, he said.

He will simultaneously be keeping a sharp eye out for potential pilot programs that will demonstrate the value of the county-level approach.

'We have resources at the state level and at the regional level," Wolf said. "The philosophy of county solutions is to do the same work at the county level. The foundations are starting to take an interest in community-based efforts. The opportunity I see is that counties can become leaders in making community-based efforts work. Wallowa County commissioners have ideas to consider right now. I think there are some prospective projects."
