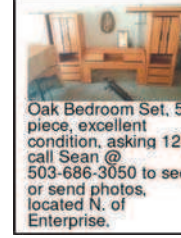

### PUBLIC NOTICE AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The County of Wallowa is eligible to apply for a 2015 Community Development Block Grant from the Oregon Business Development Department. Community Development Block Grant funds come from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The grants can be used for public facilities and housing improvements, primarily for persons with low and moderate incomes.

Approximately \$11.5 million will be awarded to Oregon non-metropolitan cities and counties in 2015. The maximum grant that a city or county can receive is \$3,000,000.

The County of Wallowa is preparing an application for a 2015 Community Development Block Grant from the Oregon Business Development Department for Microenterprise Assistance in Wallowa, Baker and Union Counties which would consist of classroom training for micro entrepreneurs. It is estimated that the proposed project will benefit at least eighteen persons, of whom 51% will be low or moderate income.

A public hearing will be held by the Wallowa County Board of Commissioners at 10:00 a.m. on September 8, 2015 at the Wallowa County Courthouse, Thornton Room. The purpose of this hearing is for the Board of Commissioners to obtain citizen views and to respond to questions and comments about: Community development and housing needs, especially the needs of low and moderate income persons, as well as other needs in the community that might be assisted with a Community Development Block Grant project; and the proposed project.

Written comments are also welcome and must be received by September 4, 2015 at 101 S River Street, Room #202, Enterprise, OR 97828. Both oral and written comments will be considered by the Board of Commissioners in deciding whether to apply.

The location of the hearing is accessible to persons with disabilities. Please contact the Commissioners Executive Assistant at 541-426-7730 if you will need any special accommodations to attend or participate in the meeting.

More information about Oregon Community Development Block Grants, the proposed project, and records about the County's past use of Community Development Block Grant funds is available for public review at 101 S River Street, Room #202 during regular office hours. Advance notice is requested if special accommodations are needed, please notify the Commissioners Executive Assistant at 541-426-7730 so that appropriate assistance can be provided.

Permanent involuntary displacement of persons or businesses is not anticipated as a result from the proposed project. If displacement becomes necessary, alternatives will be examined to minimize the displacement and provide required/reasonable benefits to those displaced. Any low and moderate income housing which is demolished or converted to another use will be replaced.
