PolioPlus

Rotarians participate in major county parades, collecting donations for PolioPlus, Rotary International's program to eradicate polio from the planet. Since 1975, when 49,293 cases of polio were recorded, Rotary has spearheaded this program, which has reduced the number to 41 in just two countries.

Project Salvador

Youth Exchange Program

Job Shadow Day

We initiated and support Project Heartbeat, a nonprofit that installs automated external defibrillators throughout Wallowa County and trains residents in their use in case of cardiac arrest.
