New Enterprise clinic combines traditional, alternative approaches

A new medical practice in Enterprise owned and operated by Billie Kaska-Suto, D.C., F.N.P.-C is accepting new patients.

Dr. Kaska-Suto received her doctorate of chiropractic by age 24 and has practiced chiropractic medicine for the past 20 years. She recently returned to school and obtained her nurse practitioner degree with specialization in family medicine. She and her husband moved to Enterprise 15 years ago when they purchased Alpine Chiropractic..

Dr. Kaska-Suto said combining her current doctorate of chiropractic with a family nurse practitioner degree allows her to address more of her patients' needs in a cost-efficient way.

"Health care is always a challenge in a rural community," she said. "I figured I could

offer a unique perspective to the residents of Wallowa County by offering them a cost-efficient, convenient alternative to traditional medicine. I would be the first in our county to offer alternative medicine and traditional medicine by the same practitioner all under one roof and one office."

She is excited to be the first female dual-licensed practitioner/primary care provider in the county.

"Integrating traditional medicine with alternative medicine makes my practice unique," she said. "There are less than 300 practices like mine in the country, which makes me a pioneer."
