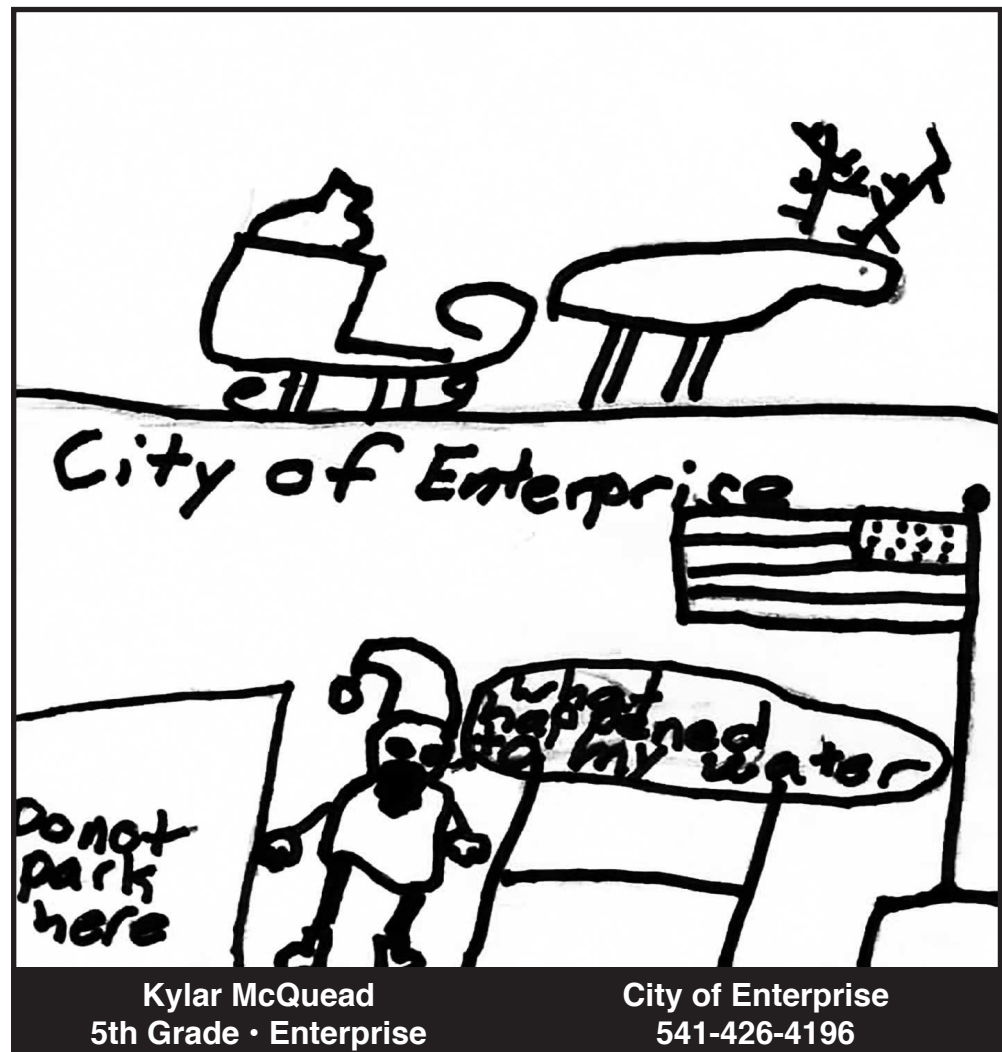
get good jobs that pay if they don't have jobs. Let every one have food on Christmas. Let everyone have a Merry Christmas.

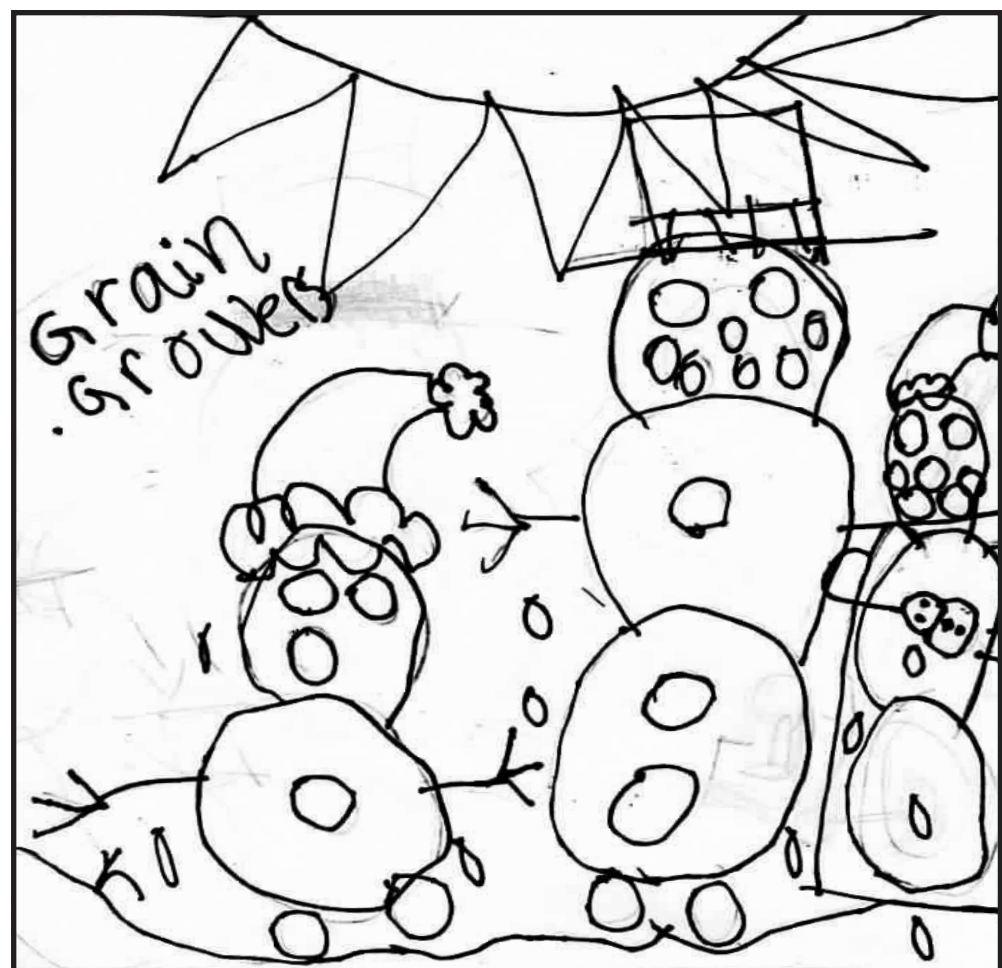

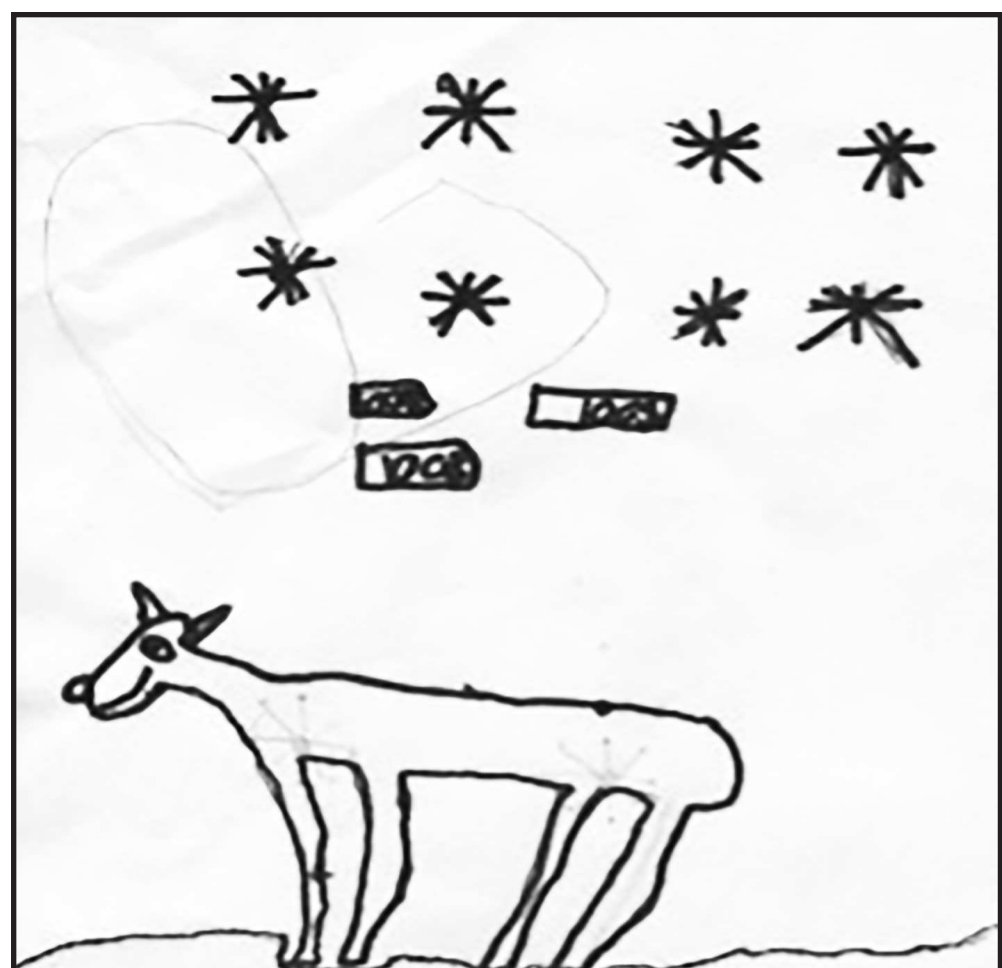
