knit. Her favorite thing is to knit so I hope she gets knitting needles and turquoise yarn.

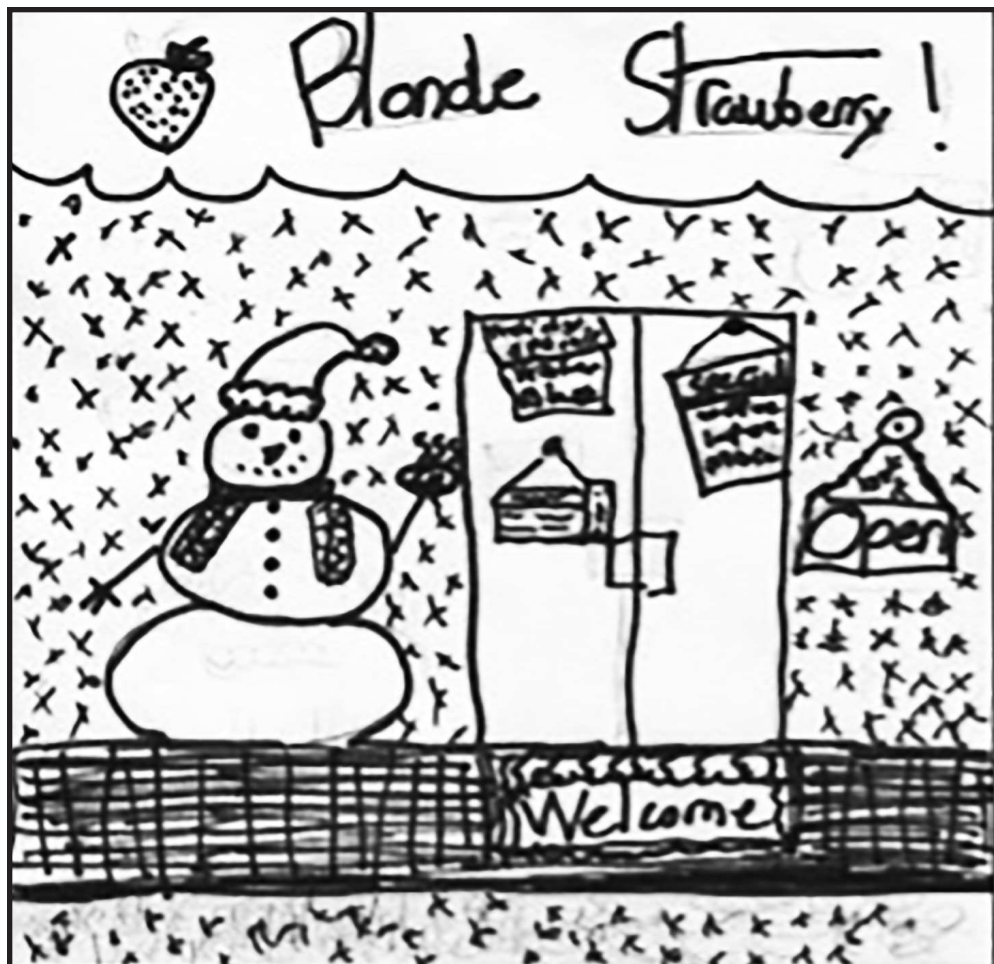

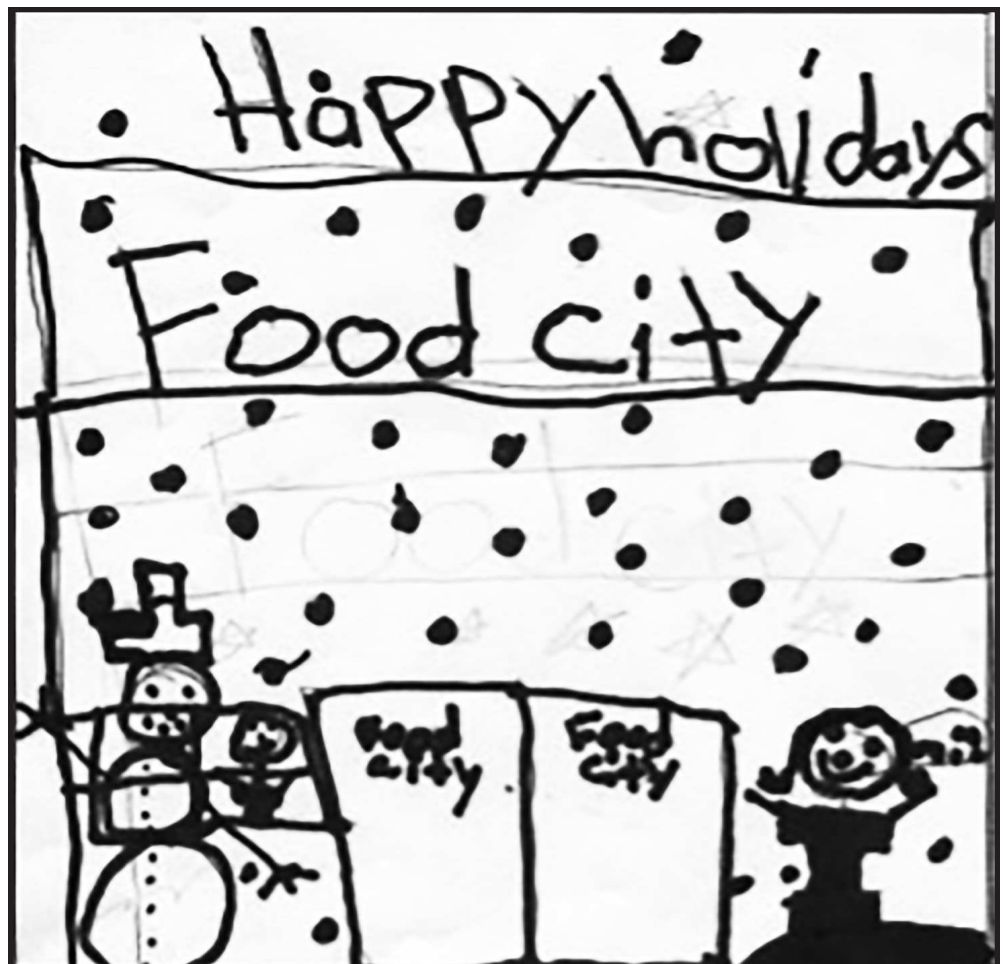
Dear Santa,

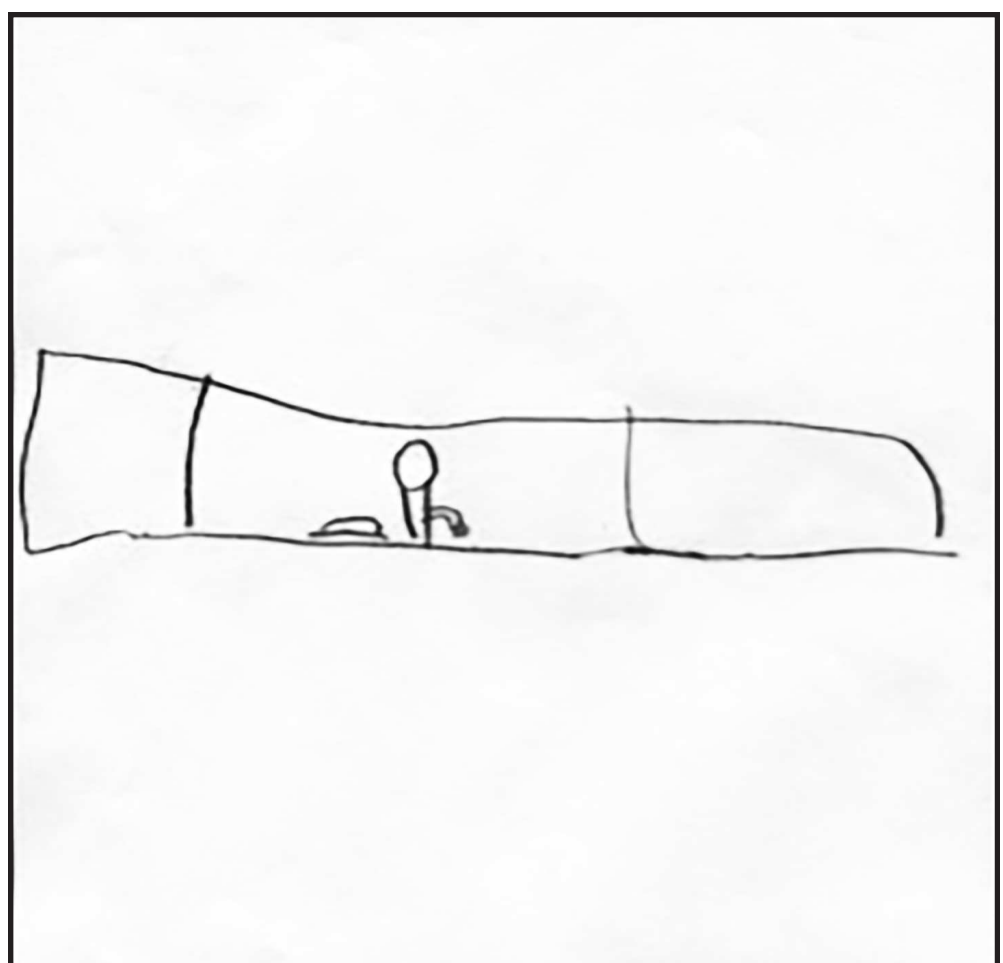
