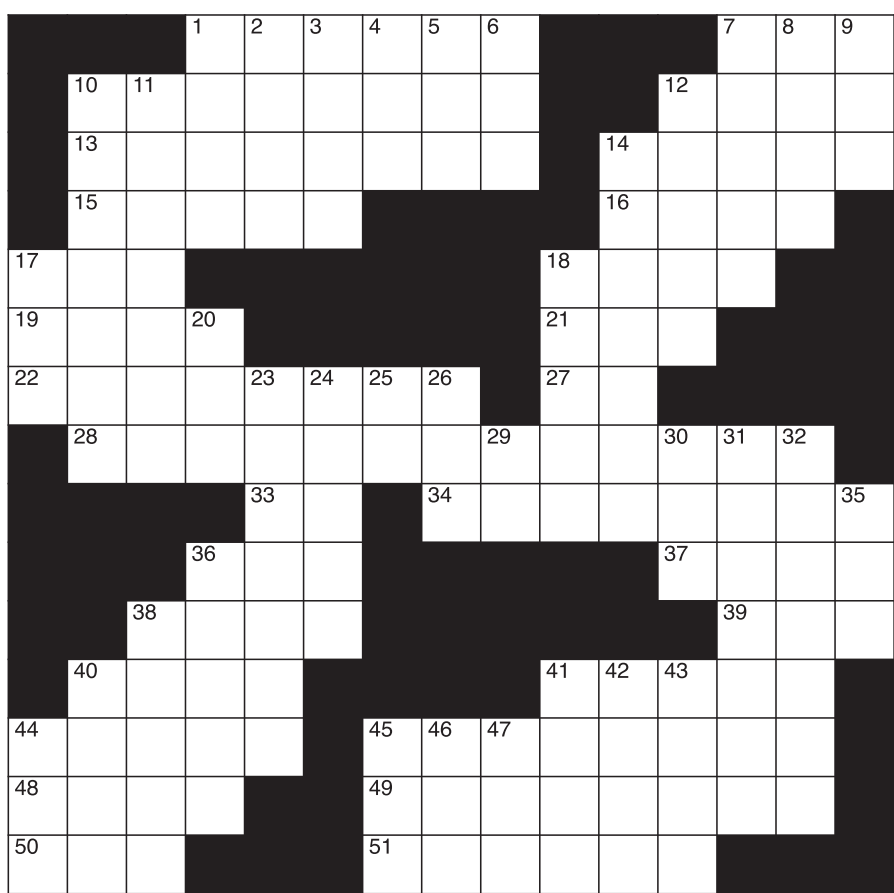

Enter Wallowa County digital photo contest

The 10th annual Wallowa County digital photo contest gets underway next month, and the submissions are accepted starting January 1.

The contest is open to all amateur photographers from Wallowa County those who vacationed here, and can be of any subject and snapped at any time.

All submitted photos will be displayed on the Chieftain's website as they are received. Each contestant may submit as many as five photos, with each photo being of a distinct subject. Photos that were previously winners of the contest are not eligible to be resubmitted.

There are two divisions, those for students age 17 and younger and for adults.

The People's Choice awards will be given to the most popular submitted photos, with 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in each division. Everyone can vote by browsing the Chieftain's contest web page and choosing their favorite student photo and their favorite adult photo. Prizes are \$40, \$20, \$10, plus certificates.

Overall best photos, with 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in each of the two divisions is determined by the judges. Prizes are \$40, \$20, and \$10, plus certificates. Honorable Mentions may be awarded at the discretion of the judges. Prizes for Honorable Mentions will be certificates.

Submissions to the contest may be made beginning Jan. 1 and will be accepted through Jan. 21. Voting for the People's Choice award is from Jan. 22 to Feb. 5. Winners will be announced in the Feb. 15 issue of the Chieftain.

All submissions must be digital – prints and slides are not accepted. However, prints and slides may be scanned and digital copies submitted. Digital photos may be submitted via the Chieftain's online submission form or emailed to wallowaphoto@gmail.com. CDs may be mailed to Wallowa County Chieftain, P.O. Box 338, Enterprise, OR 97828. CDs may also be dropped off at the Chieftain office (209 NW 1st, Enterprise, OR).
