NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER CW-95 AND CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION

CW-95 filed by Woody and Megan Wolfe, 81544 Hwy 82, Wallowa, OR 97885, proposes to convert 871.5 acres from flood irrigation to high efficiency center pivot irrigation. The project on the Lostine (aka South Fork Wallowa) and the Wallowa Rivers is expected to conserve at total of approximately 7.33 cubic feet per second (CFS) and 1234 acre-feet (AF) as follows:

Certificate 3012: 1883 Priority; Lostine River; conserving 1.21 CFS and 215.25 AF on 143.5 acres located in SE¼ of Sec. 30, T1N, R43E, W.M.

Certificate 79891: May 1897 Priority; Lostine River; conserving 0.23 CFS and 40.2 AF located on 26.8 acres located in N½ of NE¼ of Sec. 31, T1N, R43E, W.M.

The Applicants propose 100% of the conserved water (831.12 AF) be allocated to the state for instream purposes for all certificates except Cert. 53047. The Applicants propose 73% of the conserved water under Cert. 53047 (336.3 AF) be allocated to the state for instream purposes. The remaining 27% of Cert. 53047 will be retained by the Applicants for future out-of-stream use.

The Applicants propose to change the point of diversion for the 118.8 acres involved in this application under Certificate 81644 by moving it downstream approx. 5 miles from the Westside Ditch located in NWSE of Sec. 27, T1S, R43E, W.M. to the Foster Ditch located in NENW of Sec. 4, T1N, R43E, E.M. The project appears to be consistent with the requirements under ORS 537.470. Any interested person may submit written comments for the applications. Comments must be received within 20 days of the last day of publication, 01/11/2017.
