Healthcare worker training available

A course in home care is offered monthly by the Aging and People with Disabilities and Oregon Home Care Commission in Enterprise. Classes are July 19, Aug. 16, Sept. 20, Oct. 18, Nov. 15 and Dec. 13, 2017 at 104 Litch Street, Enterprise.

The course is an introduction, which can equip students with information needed to become a registered health care provider. Graduates are part of the Service Employees International Union 503 and are paid \$14.50 an hour. They may also qualify for Oregon Health Plan Plus insurance and paid time off.

The call for healthcare workers in Wallowa County is flexible, depending on need, according to instructor Kieran Dugan. More advanced trainings in care of those with catastrophic brain injury or diabetic care and many other specialty areas are available through Oregon Home Care Commission.

Workers who have been background-checked and completed the basic training are entered into an online registry, and individuals searching for an aide in any county statewide can find a home care worker.

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
