SPECIMEN BLOOMS

DEFINITIONS:

BLOOM: An individual flower: 1 blossom to a stem

SPECIMEN: A single bloom, spike, stalk or plant

SPIKE: A stalk carrying many stemless or nearly stemless flowers

SPRAY: A portion of a plant with a number of flowers

STALK: on one stem
Stiff stem which may branch, with one or more flowers.
