## Surprise gift from a visitor honors two local veterans

Earlier this month, two Wallowa County Desert Storm veterans received a surprise gift of Quilts of Valor from a visitor to Wallowa County.

Leslie Mullins of Palatka, Fla., was visiting her sister, Cathy Mullins of Wallowa, on her way home from an Alaska vacation and heard about the two veterans who lived on Riverside Ave. near Cathy.

The sisters could not pass

up the opportunity to present quilts to Eric Lueb and Jamie Quinn of Wallowa.

Cathy doesn't quilt, so Leslie had the quilts shipped from Florida for the veterans.

Quilts of Valor has awarded more than 160,000 quilts since its beginning in 2003 and an estimated 4,000 quilters across the nation make quilts for service members and veterans.

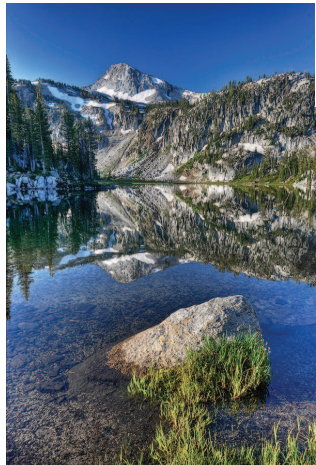

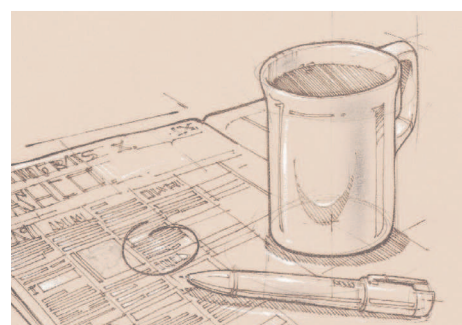
