Schaafsma CUP#17-11 Findings- Proposal to permit the installation of one 85kw impulse turbine and induction generator on the existing irrigation water pipeline on Schaafsma Ranch property. The property in question is owned by Thomas and Lori Schaafsma and described as Township 3 South, Range 46, Section 7, tax lot 2100, consists of approximately 156 acres, and is zoned Exclusive Farm Use (EFU).
