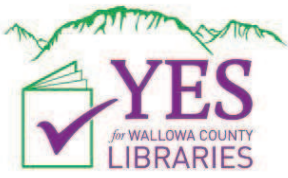

Habitat Restoration on Midway Atoll in the Pacific Islands

Presented by Ecologist Rob Taylor, PhD
Born and raised in New York City by not exactly nature-loving parents, Rob isn't sure how he ended up doing conservation work. His path brought him to Wallowa County, spending over 10 years leading an ecological monitoring and research program for the Conservancy's Zumwalt Prairie Initiative.
