

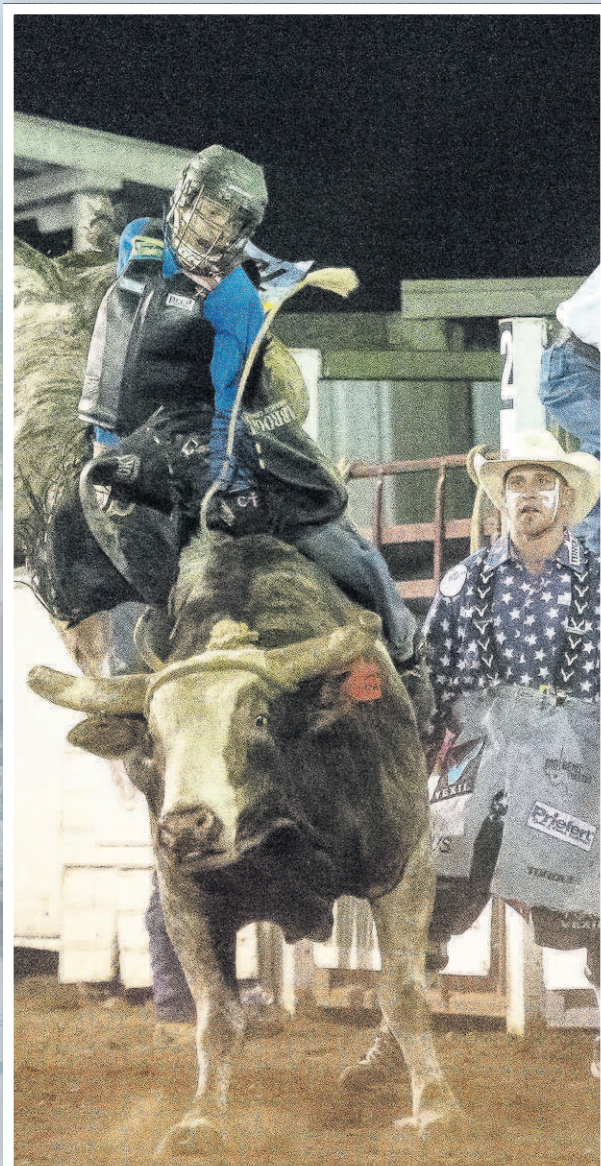


Trevor Knowles of Mt. Vernon, Ore., catches his steer during Saturday's performance. His time was 6.2 seconds, good enough for the go-round lead.
