Ecologist David Mildrexler will lead a hike exploring the Huckleberry Mountain Roadless Area which lies on the north flanks of the Wallowa Mountains. Rich in old growth forest and wildlife habitat, Huckleberry is a critical part of the Eagle Cap Wilderness Additions.

Come explore the area's diverse forests, picturesque views, and beautiful creeks as we hike the Bear Creek Trail. We'll talk about the area's ecology, and how the recently released Blue Mountains Forest Plan proposes to manage our irreplaceable roadless areas.
