NTERPRISE While the Branch Family Health Clinic has been taken over by the Wallowa County Health Care District, the adjoining Olive Branch Pharmacy continues with business as usual, the pharmacy manager said.

The 10-year-old pharmacy is owned by Bob and Sue Coulter, of Cove.

In January, the health care district announced it would be taking over the clinic effective this month. But the pharmacy remains a separately-owned business divided from the clinic by just a doorway.

Wallowa Memorial Hospital "now owns the clinic part," Blackwood said.

"We wanted to get the word out because the pharmacy owners and staff are continuing to provide the same compassionate care so that all of our patients can live a healthier life," Blackwood

She said the pharmacy does its utmost for patients.




