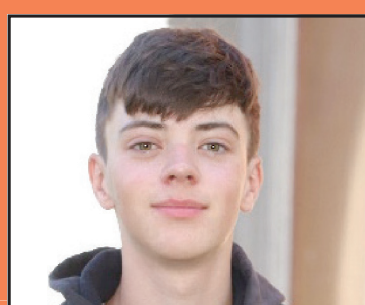




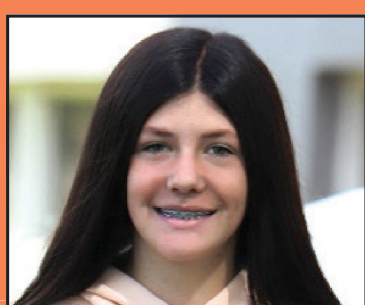
Wesley Alexis

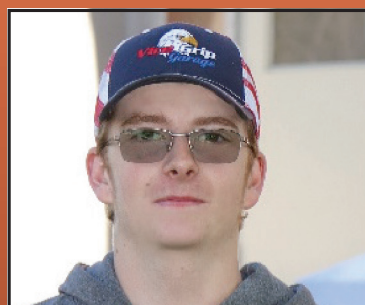
Joel Tillery

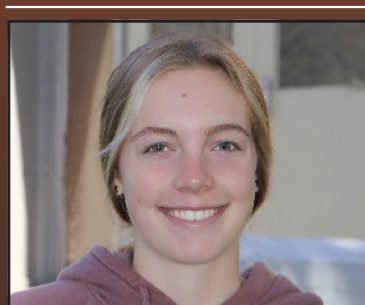
Gody Riverman

 Cody has one speed during class and that speed is full throttle. Treats himself and classmates with respect.



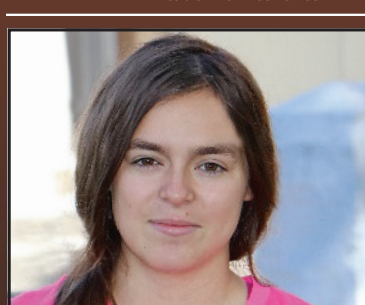
Frank Westerman

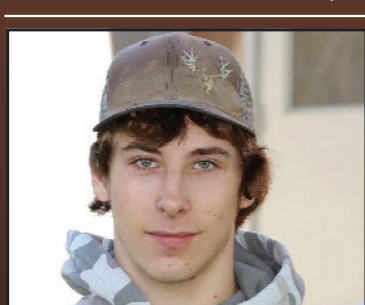
Amelia Durning

 Jossey has made great gains in her school-work and in her confidence. She has believed in herself and is unstoppable!



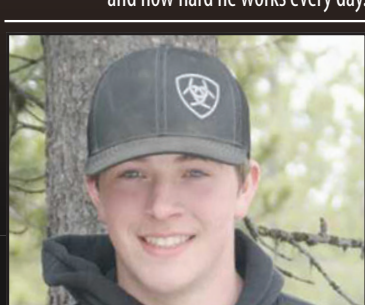
Lane Tanzey
