SIEBE CUP#21-06 FINDINGS - Conditional Use Permit submitted by Kathy and Scott Siebe is a request for a Home-Based Occupation in the form of a Bed and Breakfast in the Existing Lot (EL-1) zone. The property in question is described as Township 2 South, Range 44, Section 0900, and Tax Lot 1400. It is more commonly known as 81400 Reavis Lane, Enterprise, OR 97828 and consists of approximately 33.06 acres.
