BAKER CITY — Larry and Peggy Haney — who tour together as the duo Ghost Wind — are set to play Sunday, Aug. 15, for the Powder River Music Review.

The music begins at 4 p.m. at the Powder River Pavilion in Baker City's Geiser-Pollman Park. Admission is free, although donations are welcome to support the music series, which relies on grants, sponsorships and community donations.

Raffle tickets, also supporting the music series, are sold at each concert — \$5 each or 15 for \$20 — for a chance to win the week's gift basket.

Ghost Wind is based in Wallowa County.

"We're busy making records and writing songs," Larry Haney said.

And busy playing concerts. This week alone sees Ghost Wind taking the stage in four different places: the Courthouse Concert Series in Enterprise on Thursday, Aug. 12, at 5:30 p.m.; Wallowa Lake Lodge on Friday, Aug. 13, at 5 p.m.; a vineyard in Walla Walla

on Saturday, Aug. 14; then Baker City for the Aug. 15 concert.

Haney describes the musical style of Ghost Wind as "folk with a native flair, country, and (the) country side of rock."

"We'll do some original tunes, and good old country swing," he said. "Maybe even a jazz tune or two. It's kind of a conglomeration."
