**Second Place, 3D:** Tom Clement — "Elkhorn Peaks"

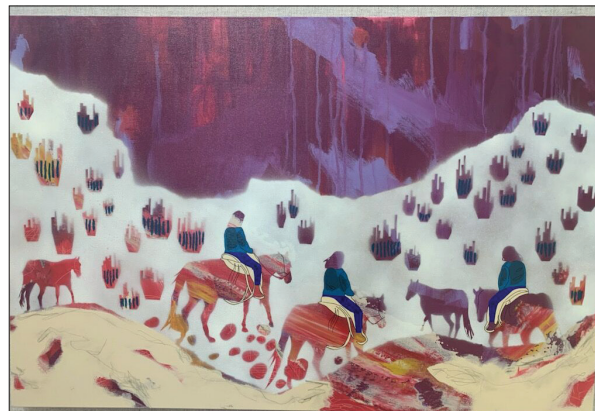

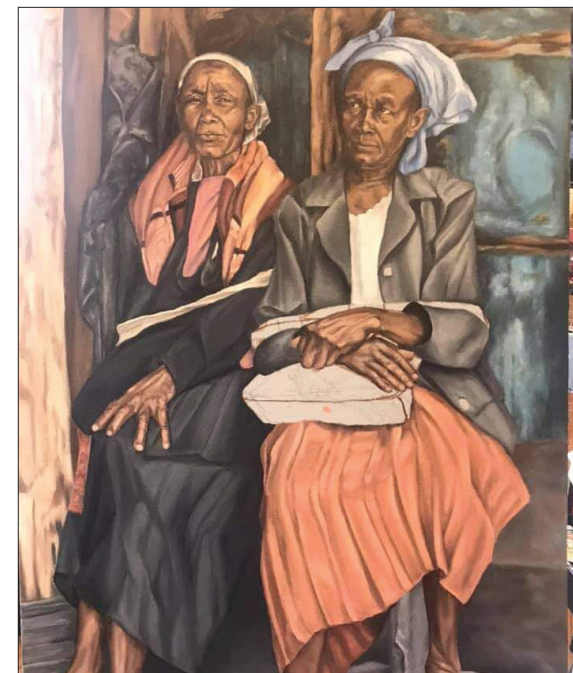
