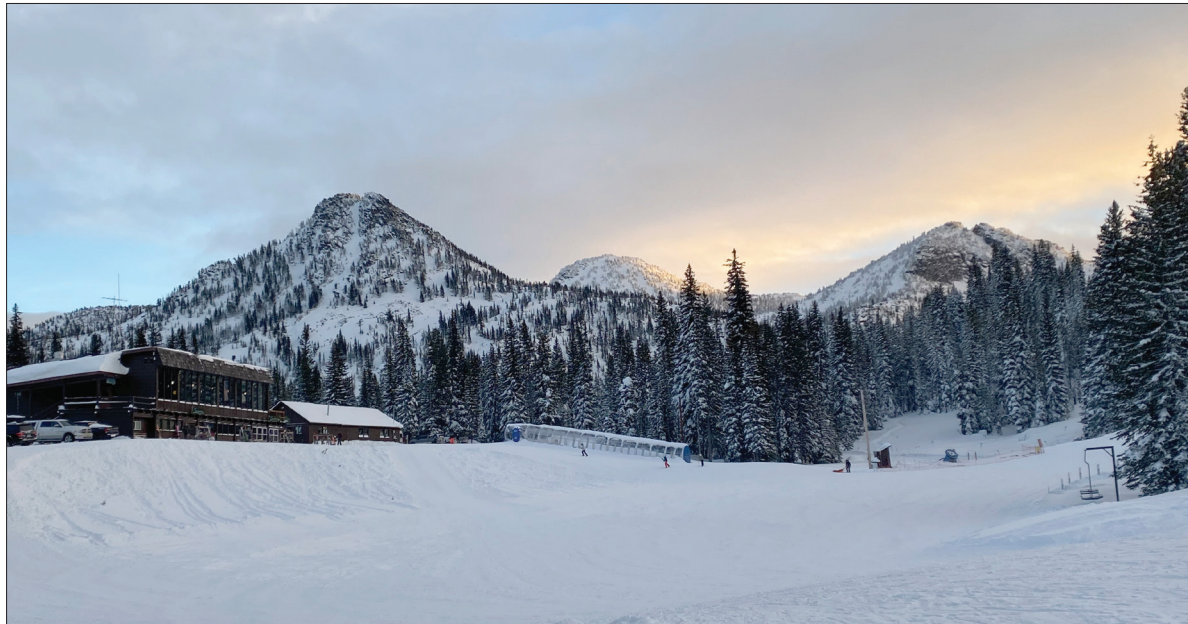
Judy said the all runs on the mountain are open, and the trails for Nordic skiing are groomed. She said cross-country skiing has been popular this year.

and includes a free lift ticket, rental and mandatory lesson.

Youth register from 8:30-9:45 a.m. in the lower level of the main lodge. Bring a school ID or current report card.

An accompanying adult receives a \$25 lift ticket if they want to ski. There is no need to pre-purchase or pre-register. The discount is received at registration.

This winter's program started Jan. 9 and runs through February. Youth who attend seven of the eight Sundays may then purchase a season pass for the remaining season and following winter for \$150.

ALICE'S WONDERLAND
