

CONFIDENCE VOTE ENDS FIGHT TO KILL LLOYD-GEORGE RULE

London, Oct. 31.—The offensive against the Lloyd-George administration apparently has been stopped.

The house of commons last night voted confidence in the government's financial policy, 405 to 20. Austen Chamberlain, chancellor of the exchequer, introduced a resolution putting the house on record as promising "heartily support to the government in all reasonable proposals, however drastic, for the reduction of expenditures and the diminution of debt."

Following a debate in which the government was defended by Premier Lloyd-George, War Minister Churchill and Andrew Bonar Law, administration spokesman, an amendment to the resolution was introduced by John Clynes, laborite. This was defeated by a majority of 355 after which the government resolution was adopted unanimously.

Lloyd-George referred to the peace treaty as "very drastic" and said that without it "we would have substituted a deficit for a deficit and the government would have deserved impeachment."

LIENS INCREASED ON JORDAN VALLEY LAND

An increase from \$71 to \$100 per acre for liens on Carey act lands in the Jordan valley irrigation project in Malheur county was voted at a meeting of the state desert land board today. The increase is on the unsold land only and is created with the proviso that should profit to the contractor result because of the increase such profit shall be divided equally between the contractor and the state.

The increase is created to care for increased cost of completing the project because of higher costs of labor and materials because there is not as much land included in the project as was originally estimated. The project as contemplated by the board includes the construction of a storage reservoir to hold 127,000 acre feet of water, having a dam 40 feet in height and a canal five miles in length.

JAPANESE RATIFY AND SIGN TREATY OF PEACE

Tokio, Oct. 30.—(United Press.)—The Japanese government today ratified the German peace treaty. The emperor signed the pact after the treaty committee of the privy council had unanimously approved it.

Japan is the fourth allied power to ratify the treaty. She has given assurance that immediately after ratification she will fix a definite time for returning Shantung to Chinese sovereignty.
