CONFIDENCE VOTE ENDS FIGHT TO KILL LLOYD-GEORGE RULE

London, Oct. 81.-The offensive against the Lloyd-George administration apparently has been stopped.

The house of commons last night voted confidence in the government's financial policy, 405 to 20. Austen Chamberlain, chancellor of the exchoquer, introduced a resolution putting the house on record as promising hearty support to the government in all reasonable proposals, however dras tic, for the reduction of expenditures and the diminution of debt." Folowing a debate in which the gov-

erament was defended by Premier Lloyd-George, War Minister Churchill and Andrew Bonar Law, administration spokesman, an amendment to the resolution was introduced by John Clynes, inborite. This was defeated by a majority of 355 ,after which the government resolution was adopted unanimously

Lloyd-George referred to the pea treaty as "very drastie" and said that without it "we would have substituted a defeat for a deficit and the government would have deserved impeachment.

LIENS INCREASED ON JORDAN VALLEY LAND

An increase from \$71 to \$100 per acce for liens on Carey act lands in the Jordan valley irrigation project in Malheur county was voted at a meet-ing of the state desert land board today. The increase is on the unsold land only and is created with the provise that should profit to the con-tractor result because of the increase such profit shall be devided equally between the contractor and the state The increase is created to care for increased cost of completing the pro-ject because of higher costs of labor and materials because there is not as much land included in the project as was originally estimated. The project as contemplated by the board includes the construction of a storage reservolu to hold 127,000 acre feet of water, having a dam 40 feet in height and a canal five miles in length.






