

COAL MINERS WILL CONTINUE FIGHT TO BETTER CONDITIONS

Indianapolis, Ind., Nov. 14.—Coal miners did not go down to defeat when they submitted to mandatory order of the federal court and canceled the strike.

This statement was issued to the United Press by John L. Lewis, acting president of the miners.

They will continue their fight for a new wage and working agreement with the operators when they go into conference with their employers and government representatives at Washington tomorrow, he said. They expect "a square deal."

"The miners are not defeated," Lewis declared. "They have acquiesced in the demand of their government. They now expect a demonstration of good faith in the negotiations by that same government."

"The only thing that can restore peace and tranquility to the mining industry is a just recognition of the meritorious claims of the mine workers in the matter of shorter hours, increased wages and improved working conditions."

"I shall attend the Washington conference in all good faith and shall meet with interest a manifestation of equal good faith by the coal operators and the government."

80 MEN AND 7 WOMEN ARE DECORATED FOR SERVICE DURING WAR

(United Press Staff Correspondent) Washington, Nov. 13.—Eighty men and seven women were to be decorated today by the Prince of Wales for distinguished service in the war. The list included three admirals, seven generals, seven privates and seven nurses.

Following this ceremony the prince visited many public buildings, went to Mount Vernon and called on President Wilson.

Knox, war college and Captain O. G. Murfin, navy yard, Philadelphia.

James Rowan, out on bail from Chicago, James Robertson, Fred Kennedy, James Rittenhouse, Harry Grady and Harry Grimme, all alleged leaders of the industrialists, are being hunted by the police.

One report says that they still are in hiding in the city.

With more than 100 alleged I. W. W. strained through the police net here late last night raids are continuing early today.

As fast as police detachments dump batches of alleged I. W. W. into the central station they are sorted out, examined by three separate sets of investigators and either jailed or released with a stern warning to stay away from I. W. W. hangouts.

Seven raids were staged yesterday and last night.
