



## Oil Production Gains Three Per Cent Over 1917

A gain of three per cent over the record production of petroleum in 1917 is indicated in the preliminary estimate for 1918. An estimate of nearly 350,000,000 barrels, as against the record for 1917 of over 335,000,000 barrels, is made. The reserve of crude oil held by all producers and pipe-line companies in the United States at the end of 1918 is estimated at 123,000,-600 barrels, as compared with 150,-000.000 barrels at the end of 1917.
