The two former military leaders were scheduled to take the stand Monday, but the squabble started by Dr. Von Helfferich, former vice-chancellor probably will cause a delay. The committee broke up in a tumult today when Helfferich refused to answer questions put by Herr Cohen, independent socialist. 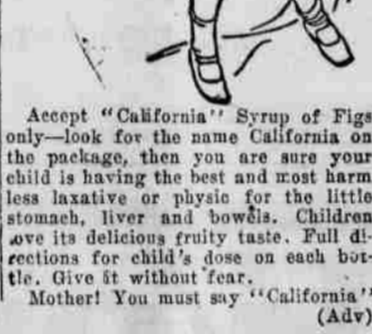
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### SEATTLE TO ABANDON CAR TRANSFER POLICY

Seattle, Wash., Nov. 18.—Seattle is to be a city without street car transfers if Superintendent of Public Utilities Thomas F. Murphine can bring about such a condition. Through the construction of a huge terminal building at Bell and Blanchard streets, from which will radiate streetcar lines to every section of the city, it is Murphine's plan to do away with transfers, speed up traffic and, with a system of elevated roads and subways, bring the city's rapidly congesting car traffic up to a point where the crowds can be handled. The elimination of transfers, it is estimated, will effect a saving of nearly \$200,000 a year. The subway and elevated system would cost about \$5,100,000.

### Oil Production Gains Three Per Cent Over 1917

A gain of three per cent over the record production of petroleum in 1917 is indicated in the preliminary estimate for 1918. An estimate of nearly 350,000,000 barrels, as against the record for 1917 of over 335,000,000 barrels, is made. The reserve of crude oil held by all producers and pipe-line companies in the United States at the end of 1918 is estimated at 123,000,000 barrels, as compared with 150,000,000 barrels at the end of 1917.

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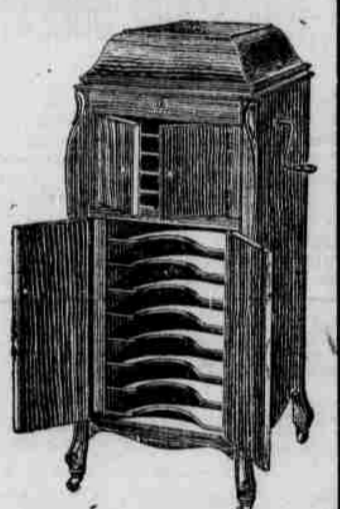

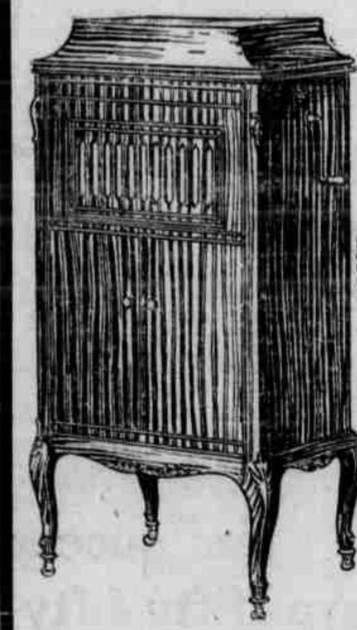
