Until some political settlement can be obtained for the Near East and some government established in responsibility for the care and .epatriation of the Armenian population in the Caucasus, this mass of people must live shearly by the charity of the United States. There are in the Caucasus approximately 1,800,-000 Armenians, of whom 800,000 are entirely destitute-refugees from Turkey-and amongst them

a tremendous mass of children. "I cannot too strongly urge upon the members of the committee and their supporters the critical necessity of concentrating every possible effort to support Colonel Haskell's administration to the amounts that he requires; otherwise we shall witness one of the greatest trugedies of the entire war.'
