

Castor Oil for Lubrication Experiments made during the war indicated that caster oil is without ning motors for aerial service. Up to a point various blends of mineral and vegetable oils did well enough, but none of these was found capable of answering the supreme tests of sus-tained flight under a wide range of temperature and varied atmospheric conditions. Nature, somehow, had endowed the castor oil with char-acteristics that were singularly and strikingly united, as if the wants of mechanical flight had been curiously anticipated.
