News Exchange Brings Nations Closer, Is Claim

Buenos Aires, Mar. 22.—Interchange of news between North and South America through connection of the South American newspapers with the United States has brought about "a better and more thorough feeling of commercial and social brotherhood in every nation than would have been possible in anything less than decades under other conditions," Don Jorge Bitre, director of La Nacion, told members of the American club of Buenos Aires, at a luncheon recently. Speaking as a publisher Mr. Bitre said, "I consider this to be one of the great missions of journalism."

SEATTLE RAILWAY LOSES
 Seattle, Wash., Mar. 20.—Seattle's municipal street railway system has lost \$500,000 during the past year, according to a report of Harry W. Carroll, city comptroller, to Mayor Hugh M. Caldwell, made public today. The railway lost \$108,000 alone in January and even more in February Mr. Carroll's report showed. Nothing, he said, has been set aside to meet the sum of \$222,000 principal on street railway bonds due two years from now.

 Cordova, Alaska, Mar. 21.—A fish meal plant, first of its kind in Alaska, is to be installed in Cordova about May 1 by San Francisco and Montana firms. It is reported. The meal will be used for feed for cattle and poultry. Fish oil, for medicinal purposes and for use in soaps and paints, will be extracted.
