Thousand Reds March Behind Funeral Car

Butte, Mont. Apr. 28 .- One thou sand men, some of them wearing the red emblem of the I. W. W. marched through the streets of Butte today be hind the funeral car bearing the b of Thomas Manning, one of the 16 men shot in the clash between strikers and officers near the Noversweat none entrance last Wednesday after-noon. Mauning died Suday morning. His funeral took place from St. Pat-rick's church and was made the occa-sion for a large gathering of strikers and their sympathizers. No banners were displayed by the marchers today and the demonstration was orderly

More men went to work in the mines this morning, but the various companies are still short-handed. Not much more than 50 per cent of the normal force is at work. No pickets were posted by the strikers this morn-ing. United States soldiers patrolled the avenues leading to the mines. Officers are investigating reports that shots were fired at men going back to work, but have made no arrests in this connection. Industrial mine workers union number 866 L. W. W., which OAT Meal Paper, 20-inch tun, extra special, 34c double roll. Max O. called the strike against the mines, is trying to bring about a general strike in the state on May I as a "protest" against the shooting of strikers in the rioting of last Wednesday. None of the international uplons in Butte or Anaconda has considered the proposal as far as known here. Word came from Great Falls that some union m may go out on May 1 but no general tieup is anticipated.
