STARTING STOCK CAUSING DEPRECIATION—The Litchfield pasture in the Oak Lodge addition is causing a great deal of trouble on account of cattle having almost no grazing, owing to the drought. There are almost no fences, in some places a wire and a board and almost no posts to support them, and the stock, some eight or ten head, are breaking out and grazing on gardens and grain fields. Edward Earl who has thirty acres wheat has suffered from their depredations and has several times had to drive them off his land and put them back into the Litchfield pasture. The damage done to his grain is estimated at \$50 and the city may have a law on its hands, as all the property is inside the city limits. It is against state and city laws for cattle to run loose in the city. The Journal report that Mr. Earl fenced the cows loose, is an error, as Mr. Earl rents the land of R. W. Gill and has been fighting to save his grain from starving stock. The police have been annoyed to death by complaints in the Oak Lodge district about the depredations of the starving stock and find it useless to turn them back into a pasture that is practically open and unfenced but for which the owners charge so much per head for each animal.
