

Salem Adds Sixth Victory to Series Record In Season

A comedy of errors and easy pitching on the part of the visitors afforded a continued round of pleasure for the fast Salem team. In the seventh inning, the competitors wearied of the sport and called the game.

In the first inning, Silverton made its hardest try for a score when it sent three men out on the sacks. There were no outs and things looked very dark for a few minutes until Ringle's hurling retired the Silverton's.

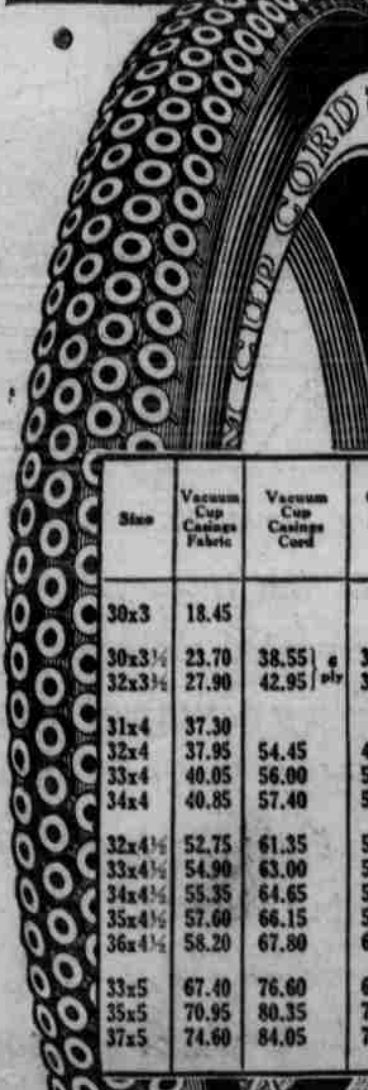

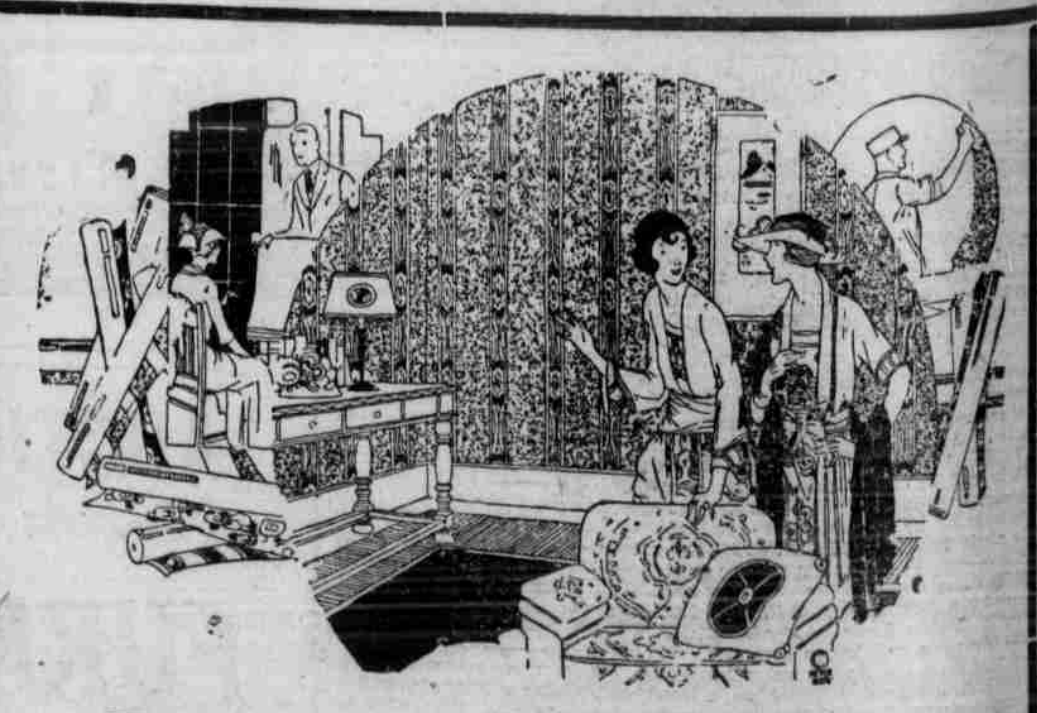
