Boston, Oct. 25.—Now that the secret is out, everybody wants to know where he got 'em. Ever since he announced that he has worn the same pair of shoes the last eighteen months, Governor Coolidge has been receiving a flood of letters, all asking the same question: "Will you please tell me where you bought those shoes?" A stenographer, "sick and tired" of reading these stories about the governor's shoes, told some stockings and expensive shoes, "polite" informed the governor that she finds it extremely difficult to worry along on her salary, and if somebody is making shoes which will stand the wear and tear of a year and a half she would like to know that firm and know it quick. She learned, to her disappointment, that the firm makes only men's footwear. The governor's mail has jumped to about 150 letters a day since he became a candidate for vice-president. In addition to those who tell him how the campaign ought to be run, who ask advice as to what investments are safe, who want him to help the Republicans, National committee, and the autograph seekers, there was the North Carolina gentleman who wanted the governor to pick out a "good school" in the north for his daughter to attend. League Factions Are Political, Is Belief of Colone Washington, Oct. 25.—Organizations advocating the league of nations are "political," even though their membership may be non-political, according to a roll call down recently by Colonel C. A. Riley, custodian of Washington's public parks and an appointee of the president. Colonel Riley refused permission to the League of Nations a resolution, recently organized by prominent women, to use Lafayette square, opposite the White House, for meetings to explain the league of nations. "The parks cannot be used for political purposes," he ruled. "But we're non-partisan," protested Mrs. Maddox Abrams, chairman. "Your purpose is political," Colonel Riley retorted at the meeting. "Speakers for the association have been compelled to take to street corners like ordinary 'soap boxes'."
