Directory Possible To Fix Sex

Says Jap Mental Concentration by Mother Is Means; Proves Successful In Many Cases

 Paris, July 21.—A possible solu-
 tion of the problem of repopulat-
 ing Europe with males to replace
 the millions lost in the war is seen
 by French scientists in the an-
 nouncement of Dr. Tu-Se-Ka-Ri,
 one of the most noted medical men
 of Japan, that parents can positi-
 vely insure the sex of their un-
 born children by a very simple
 means.

Several other "discoveries" of
 the same kind have been made in
 the past, but their exponents were
 not men of sufficient prominence
 to give their statements much
 weight. The Japanese physician,
 who describes his method in the
 current issue of the French Revue
 Mediale, was for a long time di-
 rector of the College of Tokio. He
 makes the positive assertion that
 by using his method parents can
 make certain that an unborn child
 will be either a boy or a girl, ac-
 cording to their choice, in 95 per-
 cent of all cases.

It is a very simple matter,
 writes Dr. Tu-Se-Ka-Ri. If the
 parents want a boy baby the pro-
 spective mother has only to concen-
 trate on that idea and say each
 evening before going to sleep and
 each morning on arising:
 "I will have a baby boy."
 The Japanese doctor experi-
 mented with 1942 cases before
 making his discovery public. In
 1908 cases mothers who followed
 his suggestion had their wishes
 fulfilled. He attributes failure in
 the other thirty-four cases to the
 fact that prospective mothers were
 thinking of other things when they
 repeated his magic formula and
 did not concentrate their at-
 tention.

Jacques Hardy, a French scien-
 tist, who presented Dr. Tu-Se-Ka-
 Ri's statement, not only gives its
 approval, but declares that he
 himself has tried the same experi-
 ment with six women, four of
 whom wanted boys and two girls,
 and that in each instance they had
 their wishes fulfilled. He adds
 that twenty similar experiments
 are being made by noted Paris
 physicians and that the results
 will soon be made public.
