

WILL OPEN TODD CASE ON MONDAY

Sixty-Five of Seventy Six Witnesses Called to Testify Are From Salem

Portland, Or., Oct. 21.—Sixty-five Salem residents are named in the list of 76 people who were subpoenaed Thursday afternoon by United States Attorney Lester W. Humphries to appear in the federal court here on October 31 as witnesses in the John W. Todd and Carlos L. Byron land fraud case in which Marion county people are said to have been swindled out of about \$30,000.

"That is the largest bunch of subpoenas I have ever seen issued at one time on any case in this court," said J. K. Ross, bookkeeper and deputy in the United States marshal's office.

Sixty-five from Salem. Federal officials will start serving the subpoenas today. The Salem people whose name appear in the list are:

113,733 Autos Registered Up To September 15

A table prepared by Sam A. Koser, secretary of state, shows that up to September 15, 1931, there were 113,733 motor vehicles, 2995 motorcycles, 6360 chauffeurs, 175,182 motor vehicle operators, and 606 motor vehicle dealers in the state of Oregon.

Of the 113,733 motor vehicles registered, 99,587 are passenger cars, 126 are ambulances and hearses, 99 are buses and stages, 4931 are commercial cars of less than one ton capacity, 3704 are trucks of varying capacity from one to five tons, and 264 are trailers of from one to five tons carrying capacity. Of the 8704 trucks, 5270 are from 1 to 1 1/2 tons capacity, 1451 are from 1 1/2 to 2 tons capacity, 533 are from 2 to 2 1/2 tons capacity, 341 are from 2 1/2 to 3 tons capacity, 759 are from 3 to 3 1/2 tons capacity, 104 are from 3 1/2 to 4 tons capacity, 4 are from 4 to 4 1/2 tons capacity, and 232 are from 4 1/2 to 5 tons capacity. Of the 266 trailers, 63 are from 1 to 1 1/2 tons capacity, 65 are from 1 1/2 to 2 tons capacity, 24 are from 2 to 2 1/2 tons capacity, 25 are from 2 1/2 to 3 tons capacity, 37 are from 3 to 3 1/2 tons capacity, 12 are from 3 1/2 to 4 tons capacity, and 36 are from 4 1/2 to 5 tons capacity.

Multnomah county is credited with 3078 trucks and 62 trailers, Marion county with 568 trucks and 17 trailers, Clackamas county with 424 trucks and 8 trailers, Lane county with 315 trucks and 15 trailers, Umatilla county with 312 trucks and 2 trailers, and

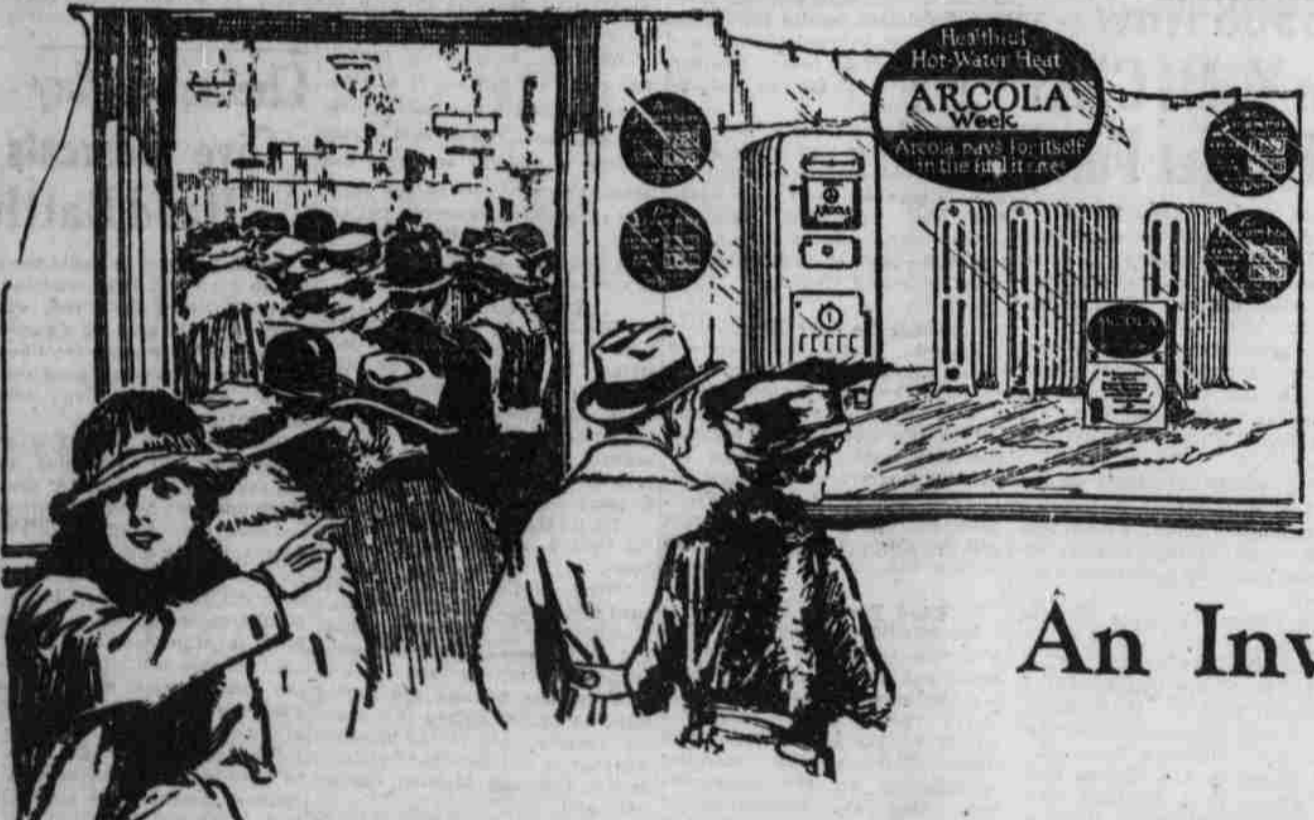
