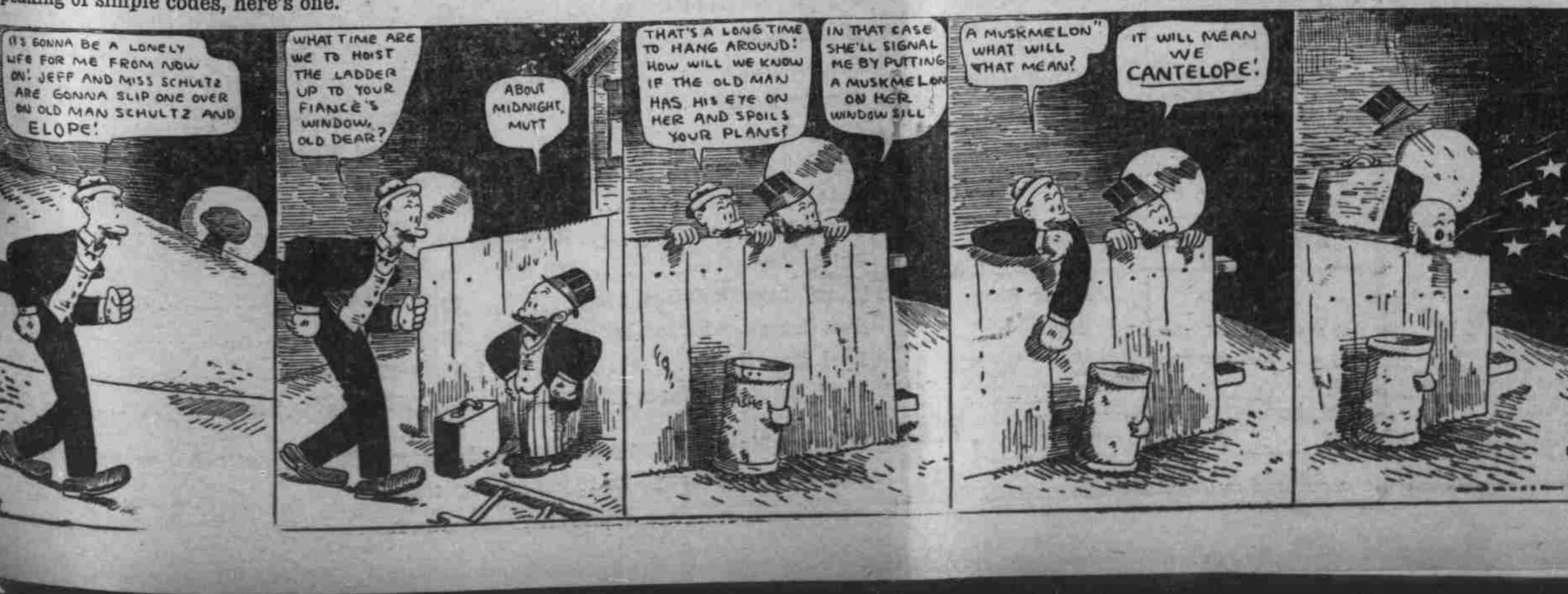

### Is Second Attempt.

On his visit to this country he was received by President Roosevelt in Washington, in September, 1908.  
 M. Hara re-entered the cabinet in 1913 as minister of home affairs, and in 1915 formed the cabinet now in office.  
 When a youth M. Hara studied law for a time but early forewent it for journalism, through which work came his introduction into the foreign office service. During a later interval in his political career, in 1896-7, he was chief editor of the Osaka Mainichi, and took up again the chief membership of that paper for a time before entering the Saionji cabinet as minister of the interior in 1904.  
 In May, 1920, a plot was discovered by assassinate Premier Hara, the details coming out in November last by publication of the findings of a preliminary court which tried a former artilleryman named Ito, charged with planning an attempt against the premier's person. Seven bombs were to have been placed on May 3, 1920, the court findings showed.
