Foch Praises Americans In Farewell Talk

New York, Dec. 21.—"I have come to love all Americans for their spirit of diligence and for their generous heartedness," said Marshal Foch in his farewell message to the American people, transmitted through the American Legion Weekly, organ of the ex-service men's organization, before sailing for home.

"With deep regret I bid you good-bye," the allied leader said. "For almost seven weeks the Legion has entertained me marvelously in your splendid country. My experience here leads to two thoughts.

"When first I met you and came to admire you as fighters, cheerful, subject to discipline under your splendid leader, General Pershing, the days were dark indeed. Yet you smiled then as you fought, and your cheerfulness and bravery helped much to bring us victory and peace.

"When next I met you it was in your country. The alarms of war were over. You were engaged actively in those pursuits of peace which are so essential to happiness and prosperity—hard work. I have come to love all Americans for their spirit of diligence, for their generous heartedness. France and the United States are indeed close together, as they always have been.

"These two thoughts—of the American abroad at war, of the American at home and at peace—lead to only one conclusion, that the Americans are young, sturdy, honorable, God-fearing, full of faith and hope; that they are to be admired, respected, trusted by all peoples everywhere.

"And of what type is the representative American today? The type you find in the American Legion. He is the man who sac-

Four Decisions Handed Down In Supreme Court

Four opinions were handed down by the supreme court Tuesday as follows:

G. L. Hunt, appellant, vs. First National Bank of Halfway; appeal from Baker county; action to recover possession of liberty bonds valued at \$339.15. Opinion by Chief Justice Burnett; Judge Gustav Anderson affirmed.

Mary H. Couch vs. Scandinavian-American bank, et al, appellants; appeal from Multnomah county; action to recover money. Opinion by Justice Brown; decree of Judge Robert G. Morrow modified.

Milton S. Hall vs. W. W. Brown, appellant; appeal from Harney county; action to recover money for damages. Opinion by Chief Justice Burnett; Judge Dalton Biggs reversed and case remanded.

J. W. Hooper vs. S. A. Pennick, appellant; appeal from Union county; action to enforce contract and lease. Opinion by Justice Bean; Judge J. W. Knowles affirmed.

Alien Land Law Constitutional

San Francisco, Dec. 21.—The constitutionality of the California anti-alien land law forbidding aliens ineligible to citizenship to own or lease agricultural land was upheld Monday by a court of three federal judges.

Several other states have enacted laws patterns on the California act.

The decision, written by District Judge Dooling of San Francisco and concurred in by Circuit Judge Hunt of San Francisco and District Judge Bledsoe of Los Angeles, arose out of the leasing feature of the act.

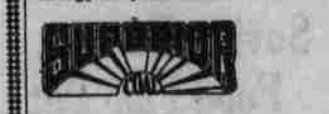

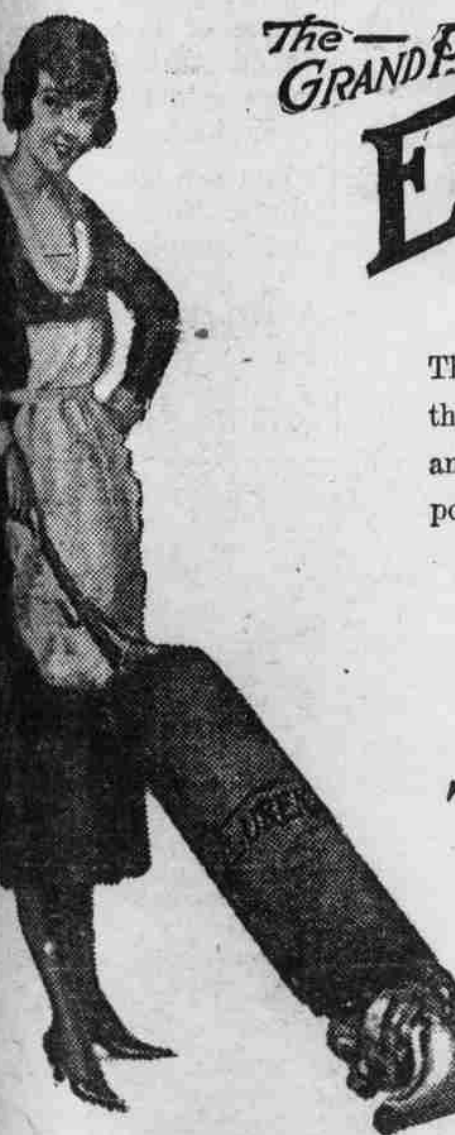
