Bids Asked On \$750,000 Road Building Jobs

Bids on road improvements aggregating approximately \$750,000 will be opened by the state highway commission at its meeting in Portland on February 21. The improvement program is distributed over five counties and includes 11.7 miles of paving, 36.1 miles of grading and 15.7 miles of rock surfacing as follows:

- Paving 10.5 miles of the Myrtle Creek-Canyonville section of the Pacific highway in Douglas county.
- Grading 3.5 miles of the Camas Valley section of the Roseburg-Coos Bay highway in Douglas county.
- Grading and rock surfacing 9.5 miles of the Rock Creek-Shutters section of the John Day river highway in Gilliam county.
- Grading 6.1 miles of the Hood River-Booth Hill section in Hood River county.
- Grading 13 miles of the Booth Hill-Forest boundary section, Mt. Hood loop highway in Hood River county.
- Graveling surfacing 6.2 miles of the Jamieson-Brocant section of the John Day river highway in Union county.
- Paving 1.2 miles of the city of Union section, Old Oregon Trail, Union county.
