Bills Put Proposal

(Continued from page one) "The merchant marine naval reserve" which the bill would establish as a component part of any reserve force of the United States Navy.

Subsidy Rate Fixed

The base subsidy rate provided for all vessels, either sailing or of 1500 gross tons or more regardless of speed, is one half of one per cent per gross ship ton per hundred nautical miles traveled.

Foreign Trade Defined

Trade between the United States and the Philippines and the Virgin Islands is defined for the purposes of the bill as foreign trade. The definition of such trade excludes that on the Great Lakes as well as trade "between ports in foreign countries where the distance between the vessel's last port of call is the one and the other is less than 150 miles."
