GERMAN REPLY ACCEPTS ALLIED TERMS IN FULL
 Genoa, April 21.—(By Associated Press)—The German reply to the allied ultimatum accepts the condition that the German delegates be barred from participating in the further discussions of the Russian questions at the Genoa conference, the Russo-German treaty signed at Rapallo being allowed to stand.
 Arrangements were made to present the note at noon today to Premier Facta of Italy, as president of the conference and also as the first signer of the protest received by the Germans.
 The German note is longer than that from the allies and begins by acknowledging "with painful surprise" the protest received which is considered undeserved. The note then repeats what Dr. Rathenau, German foreign minister, has stated on several occasions—that negotiations for the conclusion of the Russo-German treaty had begun long ago, were known to have been in progress by all the European governments, and had lately been suspended out of deference to the conference.
Plead Misunderstanding
 But the exclusion of Germany from the negotiations held by the allies with the Russians at the Ville de Albertis gave to the German delegation the impression that the allies were trying to conclude arrangements with the soviet government without German participation, perhaps to Germany's detriment.
 "At a certain moment, perhaps through misunderstanding, the German delegation received the impression that the allies were about to conclude an agreement with the Russians, therefore the Russo-German negotiations were resumed and resulted in the signing of the treaty at Rapallo Easter Sunday.
 "The German delegation believes that this treaty does not violate the spirit of the conference, and indeed contributes to its supreme aim—pacification of the world and the reconstruction of Europe."
German Envoys Divided
 The note admits that, after the conclusion of this treaty the German delegation has no reason to participate in the work of the first commission, dealing with Russian affairs, but says it will willingly participate in the other work of the same commission dealing with European and German interests.
 The delay in delivery of the note was due chiefly to differences of opinion among the Germans themselves as to the best attitude to take, some fearing the repercussion it might have in French quarters, as the French delegates had kept themselves severely aloof during the whole incident. The statement made by Premier Lloyd-George of Great Britain, before the Journalists at the meeting in the royal palace yesterday, however, was interpreted to mean that France was in perfect agreement with the other allies.

 spot in Gladstone and when the officers stopped there yesterday they heard of the find and went to the place, immediately.
Ideal Spot for Murder.
 On one side of the road is a large timber tract and on the other is the Southern Pacific right of way. It is an isolated place and there is no house nearer than a quarter of a mile. Captain Harms said it would be an ideal place to commit a murder.
 Substantiating the new theory is a report that an automobile was seen standing at practically the same place, headlights burning, about 10 o'clock Sunday night, approximately the time the murder is supposed to have been committed. Rain which fell in the intervening time had washed nearly all the blood away and only a faint blotch, which is very uncertain, was found by the officers when they reached the spot.
Traces of Blood Found.
 This was on the gravel beside the road, and Johnston identified the spot as the place where he saw the blood. Some gravel was gathered up by the officers and brought to Portland for a chemical examination. The theory will be strengthened considerably if the gravel proves to have human blood on it.
 Captain Harms said he was almost positive that the murder was committed there. Near the place tracks of automobile tires were found at the side of the road, and the print of the tread was the same as that on the tires of the car Hecker drove.
 Besides the circumstantial evidence at this site, the road is one Hecker would logically have taken. He drove Bowker out Eight-second street and said they were to meet the bootlegger a mile out on the continuation of Eight-second street. This road is the Oregon City road.
