GERMANY MAKES PAYMENT TO ALLIES
Berlin, Sept. 19.—The newspaper, according to the newsagents, has paid to the allies 10,000,000 gold marks as part of liquidation of 35,400,000 due in installment of Germany's private war debts to allied nationals.
