What's New on the Market

 "Little Neck" clams are to be found on the markets at this time. They are selling at 8 cents a shell. These clams still have the shells and are alive.
 The butter clams, sent from Olympia, as are the Little Necks, are selling at 80 cents a pint.
 "Mammoth Red" cabbage appeared on the local markets this morning for the first time this season. If the word red was changed to "Purple" the cabbage would be better named. This variety of cabbage is very palatable and adds greatly because of its color to any salad. It retails at four cents a pound.
 Savoy cabbage, a variety with crinkly leaves like those in head lettuce, appeared on the market this morning. It too, is selling at four cents a pound and is very fine in salads.
 The buying price for eggs by the shippers this morning was 44 cents a dozen, or one cent higher than earlier in the week. Practically all of the stores are paying from one to three cents a dozen more than the shippers figure. The retail price ranges from 47 to 50 cents a dozen.
