ed, and the confidence instilled in them through the knowledge that money was available acted as a stabilizer, the value of which the report said, could only be estimated.

"Large as is the number of advances made by the corporation," the report said, "it falls far short of indicating the number of farmers who benefitted from them; for even those farmers who have had no financial assistance; directly or indirectly, have nevertheless been aided by the general improvement in the credit situation in their own communities. In neighboring districts and in the country as a whole as well as by the stabilization of markets for the many products of agriculture, the condition is the same."

The report added that the gradual decrease in the number of applications for loans further reflected the general benefit which the corporations' operations have had on the agricultural credit situation. Advances for agricultural and livestock purposes totalling \$443,442,000 in 27 states had been approved up to November 30. Of this \$182,859,000 went to 4400 banking institutions, \$77,761,000 to 113 livestock loan companies and \$172,827,000 to 32 cooperative marketing associations.

CHAPIN URGES CORN SHOW BE STARTED NOW

The time to start a corn show for next year is to begin right now. L. J. Chapin, in talking to members of the Marion county federation, in session last evening at the Sunnyside school house, complimented farmers on the favorable showing made at the recent Marion and Polk county corn show. But in order to assure a bigger and better show next year, Mr. Chapin said that with the assurance of a big show in the fall of 1923, farmers would plant more carefully, and take greater care in sowing out for the show, their finest corn. Mr. Chapin is one of the pioneers in the corn show idea, having superintended a number of exhibits.

PASSION PLAY OF 1922 BARELY PAYS EXPENSES

London, Dec. 21.—Times are hard in Oberammergau as a consequence of the mark's depreciation, but the Passion players are enduring poverty rather than sacrifice the traditions of so many years by accepting the offers of motion picture companies and theatrical managers to give their play abroad.

Burgomaster Wilhelm Ritz, in appealing to English friends of the players to buy their wood carvings as means of augmenting their income, says in a letter published here that the parish, after deducting expenses, has the equivalent only of 1000 pounds as its net return for the Passion Play of 1922. The gross receipts were 21,000,000 marks, equal to 2360 pounds. In 1910 the play netted 1,500,000 marks, or 71,800 pounds.
