COMMITTEE OF FIVE TO FRAME

At the meeting of loganberry growers held yesterday afternoon in the Masonic temple, a committee of five was appointed, consisting of William H. Weeks of Kaizer Bottom, William Grauer of Sheridan, H. R. Jones of Rosedale, G. W. Lemery of Waconda and G. L. Thompson of Albany, to draft up a form of organization in each lo cality of independent logapherry growers.

After this committee has drawn up a form of contract for different localities, it will call a gener al meeting of all loganberry growers in the state, to endeavor to af fect a central organization.

At the meeting yesterday, the opinion was expressed that if the loganberry industry was to survive there must be an organization of growers that an control the output of at least 80 per cent of the crop. Without this percentage it would be useless to advertise and push loganberries and then suffer from cooperation with the central organization.

Answering the question as to what loganberries were selling for in eastern and northern markets. M. J. Newhouse of the Oregon Growers said that in Minneapolis the jobbers were asking the grocers from 38 to 40 cts, a pound for loganberries in bulk, while the reloganberries.


In Canada the retail price was much higher, Mr. Newhouse said. as there is an import and war tax duty of 28% per cent and as a result, loganberries in bulk were selling for about 70 cents a pound.

As to the advertising, Mr. Newhouse said that the Oregon Growors were advertising the Mistland prunes at a cost of one-tenth of a cent a pound, and in some localities had vastly increased the consumption during the year.
