Salem May Be Faced With Grip Epidemic

KAY ASKS DELAY IN BUILDING OF SCHOOL FOR BOYS

State Treasurer Kay, at the meeting of the state board of control yesterday, declared himself in favor of deferring action on letting a contract for construction of the proposed new state training school for boys until the legislature passes on a recommendation which the governor will present asking for additional funds for the project.

The money provided by two previous legislatures, depleted to some extent by expense incident to the acquiring of a site, are not now sufficient to complete the school as planned.

Governor Pierce said that in his message to the legislature he will advocate transfer of the entire institution to the new site near Woodburn and the conversion of the present school into a reformatory for offenders who are too old for the training school but too young in crime or years to go to the state prison.
