

SALEM, UNABLE TO FIND BASKET, DEFEATED 15-14

Several players and a big red-headed boy by the name of Scallan came to Salem from the Franklin high school of Portland yesterday evening and trimmed the Salem high school basketball team by a score of 15 to 14. Salem's inability to convert free throws cost them the game as they missed ten out of twelve free throws while Franklin shot three out of their four chances. Salem also missed enough easy field goals to more than double the score and they only played the real ball that they are capable of in the last few minutes of play.

The score at the end of the half stood 10 to 5 in favor of the visitors. Scallan, the big red-headed player, shot three long shots in the first few minutes of play and he continued to find the hoop with ease although he had a little hard luck in the last half as several of his shots went in and out again. Scallan was by far the outstanding player of the Franklin team. Salem fought hard and with only six minutes to play they started to play ball and tied the score at 13 all. A foul gave the visitors a point and the lead, and Epps, who shot the basket was given another shot as Salem rooters refused to keep quiet. Epps converted this and the score stood 15 to 13 in favor of Franklin. Ashby shot one of the two fouls converted by Salem and ended the scoring for the evening. Lyons, who went in instead of Bob Drager, gave the visitors several chances as the ball went into the possession of Franklin for too many steps. Franklin started several substitutes in the last half but when Salem came from behind the regulars were rushed into the battle again.

Fabre of Portland, who is refereeing the Portland city league games, was the official for the game. The Franklin five refused to come unless Fabre refereed. The locals have a good team this year and with a little more experience will make the rest of the teams get down and play. Ellis, Ashby and Heenan starred for the locals with their fight. Franklin showed some of the prettiest floor work seen here this season. But Salem was able to penetrate their defense with regularity, but missed the easy shots. Salem will meet the McMinnville five on the local floor tomorrow night and a hard game is promised but Salem should win. A large delegation from Independence attended the

game to get a line on the Salem five.

COOLIDGE PLAN OF WORLD COURT IS CONSIDERED

Washington, Jan. 9.—A resolution proposing entry of the United States into the world court on the basis of President Coolidge's recommendation that it shall not be bound by any advisory opinion of the court, will be considered, with other proposals, when the question of American adhesion is taken up next Wednesday by the senate foreign relations committee.

The resolution was presented in the senate late yesterday by Senator Willis, republican, Ohio, in the nature of a substitute for that offered by Senator Pepper, republican, Pennsylvania, at the last session.

Besides embodying the president's recommendation in his last annual message, the resolution also proposes the reservations put forward by Secretary Hughes and approved by President Harding carrying the stipulations that American adhesion shall not be construed as involving any legal relation with the league of nations and that the United States shall participate on an equality with league member states.
