IRVING CRATOR AT BANQUET BY REALTORS, FRIDAY

Dr. Irving E. Vining of Portland, president of the Oregon State Chamber of Commerce, will speak to the members of the Marion-Polk County Realtors association Friday evening at a banquet at the Marion hotel, to begin at 6:30 o'clock.

Reservations for plates have been coming in from Albany, Portland and other cities in Oregon, according to J. H. Scott, president of the realtors' association and member of the board of directors in charge of the banquet.

"The dining room will be available that will seat Salem's business and professional men, in addition to the outside visitors," says Mr. Scott.

"We will get the perspective of our program for the year at this banquet, which is to become an annual affair," asserted Mr. Scott. "The future of Salem and the vicinity around it will be considered in full."

"Dr. Vining, famed for eloquence, is going to forecast Salem's condition 10 years hence," says Mr. Scott. "His address will not only be interesting but instructive, and anyone fortunate enough to hear it will have an opportunity to get into the real spirit of the day."

That the realtors have a hand in development of Salem is vouchered for by Mr. Scott, who points to the part they played in bringing the flax industry to the front in the last few months.

"The Willamette valley bids to become the Belgium of America," he says. "Flax culture will at last become one of the great industries of this city and surrounding country."

Pierce Asks Many Laws in Message: Governor Pierce pleaded for all persons in the state to share in the duty and responsibility of law enforcement.
